### Logging in to Wifi at the Lancaster Campus

Welcome to LBC! One of the first things you'll probably want to do is connect your laptop to the wireless network called "LBC" so you can have internet access. This is a network just for current students and employees of LBC. Do not connect to the guest network.

If your computer runs Windows 8.1, Windows 10, or is a Mac, simply select the "LBC" network from your wireless options on your computer, then use your student username and password when prompted (your username is the first part of your email address without @lbc.edu part). If you receive a notice about an "invalid certificate" you can safely ignore it and just click ok.

For Android and Chromebook, connect to "LBC" and choose mschap v2 for phase 2 authentication. Then put your LBC username and password.

**WINDOWS 7 ONLY!!!** If your computer is still running Windows 7, you'll need to connect to the "Student Certification" wifi network **first**. After that, go to <http://www.lbc.edu/helpdesk/Wifi-Certification> and click on "Add LBC Wifi Network" which will download a file you'll need to run on your computer. After you run it, follow the directions above to connect.
