Registration Process for Returning JumpStart Students

If you have already participated in the JumpStart Program prior to **fall 2024**, then you are "grandfathered" into the program & are not required to fill out an application nor submit test scores (unless test scores are needed to meet the prerequisite for a course offered). Registration will be the same as it has been in the past for you.

Registration Process for New JumpStart Students

In order to participate in the JumpStart Program, new students will need to fill out a **JumpStart Application**, not just the online registration form. The application will require students to submit high school transcripts as well as scores from the SAT, PSAT, ACT, CLT, or CLT10. **This is very important to note due to the dates these tests are offered.**
